Authority awards \$3,180,372 contract to Heyward  
Services Inc., for 3 new vertical turbine pumps – 1600  
HP motors to replace 25-year-old pumps.

Authority adopts Resolution in Support of Construction  
of a Rock Ramp Cascade on Lock & Dam #1 as an  
alternative for Removal by the US Army Corps of  
Engineers on the Cape Fear River in Bladen County.

Authority awards annual Audit Contract for Fiscal Year  
2006-2007 to Thompson, Price, Scott, Adams &  
Company, P.A.

Authority selects BB&T Capital Markets as Financial  
Advisor for pending Revenue Bond Sale.

Authority awards \$5,485,250 contract for expansion  
and capital improvements to T.A. Loving Company.

Authority adopts Annual Budget for Fiscal Year  
2007-2008 holding the raw water rate at 21¢ per 1000  
gallons. Authority applies to N.C. Local Government  
Commission for sale of Revenue Bonds.

## Bladen Bluffs Regional Surface Water System

Brunswick County Commissioner David Sandifer joins the Authority Board of Directors.

Authority awards contract to CDM in the amount of \$21,500 to prepare an Assessment of the Impact of the Removal of Lock and Dam #2 by the US Army Corps of Engineers in Elizabethtown.

Authority executes Ground Lease and amends Treated Water Supply Agreement with Smithfield Packing Company.

Authority receives presentation from CDM regarding the Preliminary Engineering Report for the project and the Assessment of Impacts on the project if Lock & Dam #2 in Elizabethtown is removed by the US Army Corps of Engineers.

Authority secures \$300,000 in the FY08 Federal Budget within the Interior Appropriations Bill for the project.

Authority adopts Resolution in Support of Retaining Lock & Dam #2 with the Construction of a Rock Ramp Cascade for fish passage as proposed for Lock & Dam #1 & #3.

## Kings Bluff Raw Water Pump Station

**JUL**

Authority approves Sale of \$7,100,000 in Revenue Bonds for expansion and improvements. Board awards Environmental Assessment for Additional Raw Water Intake in the amount of \$39,750 to McKim & Creed of Wilmington.

**AUG**

Authority issues \$7,100,000 Revenue Bond to BB&T for 15 years at 4.09%. Authority executes Memorandum of Understanding with City of Wilmington confirming Future Raw Water Supply needs.

**SEP**

Authority issues contracts for installation of new power assemblies and parts for the two existing 2700 KW Diesel Generators in the amount of \$513,081.

**OCT**

Authority transfers 2 acres for conservation to the United States.

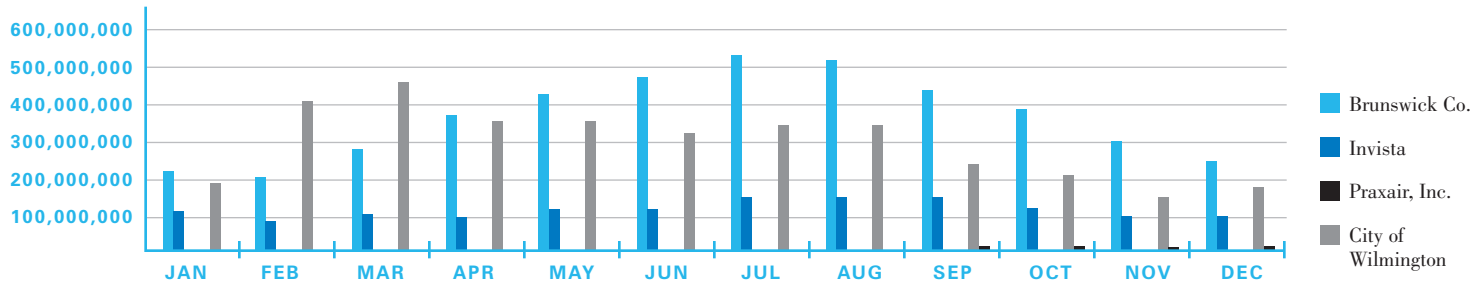
**NOV**

Authority receives presentation by McKim & Creed, P.A. on raw water storage options as a result of existing drought conditions.

**DEC**

Authority awards Professional Services contract in the amount of \$19,700 to McKim & Creed, P.A. for evaluation of future capital costs for raw water storage.
