


Dimensions (All dimensions are approximate.)

Resolution Approving Financing Terms

WHEREAS, the Lower Cape Fear Water and Sewer Authority, NC ("Borrower") has previously determined to finance the installment financing agreement for equipment (the "Project"), and the Finance Director has now presented a proposal for the financing of such Project.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, as follows:

- 1. The Borrower hereby determines to finance the Project through Truist Bank ("Lender") in accordance with the proposal dated March 7, 2023, or as such proposal may be supplemented or amended by Lender and the Borrower verbally or in writing. The amount financed shall not exceed \$130,000, the annual interest rate (in the absence of default or change in tax status) shall not exceed 4.95% and the financing term shall not exceed three (3) years from the date of closing.
- 2. All financing contracts and all related documents for the closing of the financing (the "Financing Documents") shall be consistent with the foregoing terms. All officers and employees of the Borrower are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver any Financing Documents, and to take all such further action as they may consider necessary or desirable, to carry out the financing of the Project as contemplated by the proposal and this resolution.
